

## GETTING READY FOR RECITAL

It's so hard to believe that recital is only one week away! The dancers have all worked so hard and we are so proud of their accomplishments this year. Thanks again to all the parents bringing their children week after week and for their encouragement and support! Let the show begin!!!!

### **MANDATORY** Dress Rehearsal

**Time:** 12 noon

**Place:** Plainfield High School Auditorium

**Dress:** Students do NOT need to dress in their costumes. They only need to come with their appropriate dance shoes.

This is a closed dress rehearsal. We are, however, asking for one parent from each dance group to volunteer to supervise in the auditorium until that group of students has completed their number. Once the number is so completed, the class is free to go. At rehearsal we will run the finale first and then we will run the entire show from beginning to end. As your child's last dance is completed, you are welcome to take your child and go home. We ask that, except for those who are volunteering to supervise, no other parents come into auditorium during rehearsal. You are welcome to wait in the lobby, run errands, etc. Please notify one of the workers if you are leaving. You can estimate the time of the rehearsal by planning 15-20 minutes for the finale and then approximately 3 minutes for each song (a copy of the line-up is on the back).

### The Show Must Go On Recital

**Time:** 2:30 p.m. (dancers should plan on arriving by 2 p.m.)

**Place:** Plainfield High School Auditorium

**Dress:** Please check and make sure that your child has their complete costume for each dance...**COSTUME and ALL THE ACCESSORIES, TIGHTS, SHOES, RECITAL T-SHIRT (or plain white t-shirt), BLACK SHORTS.** A brown paper bag was provided with each costume. Please place additional costumes in the bags provided (attach the paperwork that identifies their next act). The finale costume (shorts and t-shirt) are to be placed in the last bag. If your child is in only one dance, their finale costume goes in the bag with their name on the bag.

Dancer can come dressed in their first costume. Please remember to apply some stage make-up and check to see that your dancer's hair is styled per the instructions on the front of the costume bag. Remember NO underwear with the costume (tights serve as the undergarment), NO nail polish, and NO jewelry.

(FYI....there will be photo stations placed throughout the lobby. Feel free to take photos of your child in his/her costume throughout the lobby. There will be no flash photography or videotaping during the actual recital.)

### Miscellaneous Tidbits

- Tickets are on sale at the reception desk. Tickets are \$10/each. They can also be purchased at the door. Children under 3 are free.
- Flowers can be pre-ordered at the reception desk. Bouquets are \$10 or \$15.
- Recital bears can be pre-ordered at the reception desk for \$10. (Proceeds go to replacing dance floors)
- DVDs can be pre-ordered at the reception desk for \$30
- All items purchased at the Plainfield High School venue (tickets, flowers, bears, etc.) will be **CASH ONLY!!!**
