your dancer's name posted on the bulletin board in the lobby. This list will be used to create the cast list for the recital shirt as well as the program. We want to make sure that all names are spelled correctly and double check that no one is left off. Your assistance with this is greatly appreciated!

Ads on Sale for Recital Program

Souvenir programs are being prepared for the recital. In addition to a schedule of acts, this program will include a collection photos of events that have occurred at the studio over the last year.

More over, this program is a chance for family and friends to submit personal wishes for their dancer(s). Patron ads (good
