### **OOGIE BOOGIE BUCKS**

Each year, based on the gala theme, we incorporate a new student incentive program. In keeping with this year's Nightmare Before Christmas theme, this year's student incentive is the "Oogie Boogie Buck."



Here's how the rewards program works:

- Every dancer is eligible
- Throughout the dance year, teachers will be awarding students "Oogie Boogie Bucks" for exceptional behaviors, i.e., special acts of kindness, being a good listener, mastering a skill, cleaning up after themselves, etc.,
- The dancer's name will be written on the "buck" and signed by the teacher. The dancer is responsible for depositing it in the purple Nightmare jar on the front desk.
- Drawings for prizes will be held periodically throughout the year.



#### A HOME FOR "RETIRED" SNEAKERS

PDC Boosters has partnered with GotSneakers who recycles used sneakers (sneakers only) to keep them out of the landfills. These shoes are generally not made from materials that are biodegradable and add to toxic fumes of the air and into the soil. PDC Boosters receives an amount back for every pair of used sneakers that can be used towards the cost of competition and supplies. The amount per pair is based upon the condition of the footwear. Shoes are being collected in the marked bin in the back of the studio near the east exit.
